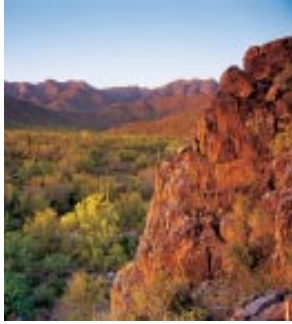

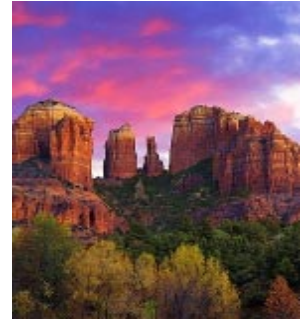

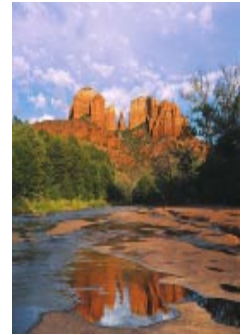
DAY 2

Named for the wife of the town's first postmaster, Sedona has developed in just 30 years from a tiny agricultural community into a major art center, resort and spiritual retreat. Pleasant temperatures prevail, as does the New Age belief that strong spiritual energies are concentrated here in vortexes, or psychic-energy points. The city also has many intriguing book stores, art galleries, and restaurants.
- *Lunch at The Orchards Bar & Grill* included upon arrival in Sedona.
- Free time in Sedona for shopping.
- *Dinner at historic Pinnacle Peak Patio* - Since 1957 Pinnacle Peak has been serving up the finest mesquite grilled steaks and chicken along with Wild West fun and entertainment with live music and dancing.
